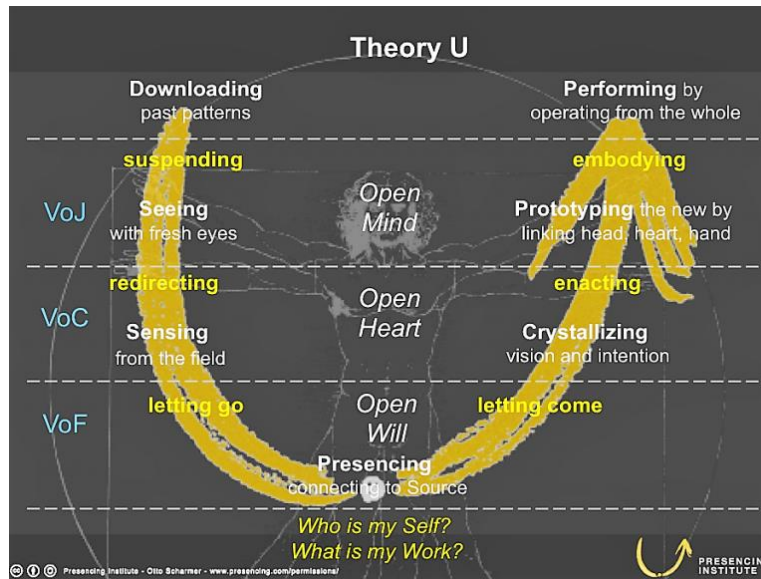

Experience and learn to apply Theory U

Action researcher C. Otto Scharmer, who researches and teaches at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), uses "Theory U" to describe a forward-looking way of implementing transformative change. The core of the theory is the realization that the effectiveness of one's actions depends on one's inner attitude and the ability to orient oneself to the future by sensing into the highest potential for the way forward. This core insight is one of the most important future skills in leadership and helps also in system change projects and complex challenges.

"You can't lead systems transformation unless you sense and actualize the future as it emerges. Leadership from a systems view is to help a system to sense a future potential. Actualize means stepping forward into an emerging possibility. The leadership capacity of stepping the unknown is even more critical as we as a community face disruption. The capacity to letting go of the past and to letting come new possibilities is what the deeper territory of leadership is about."

Objectives of the course:

With this experiential learning course we invite you to learn with all your senses to

- develop a deeper understanding of the underlying principles of Theory U through practical exercises, reflections and dialog.
- identify challenges and opportunities that ask you to apply the presencing skills of Theory U in your work and life context.

To get the most out of the course, you might want to work on a current and specific study project or professional challenge in which you have a leadership role. You will discover how to apply Theory U hands-on in your project or challenge.

What you can expect:

You will get to know the framework and some essential methods of Theory U, perceiving through your own experience the powerful effectiveness that unfolds, for example through journaling, transformative listening, Coaching Circle and 3 D Mapping accompanied with creative dialogues and co-creative design with your student fellows. You will learn about leadership from a systems point of view.

Together we'll explore the question: "How can we act from the emerging future and how do we activate the deeper, creative layers of the social field?".

On the course days we practice pausing together to perceive and experience the connection with ourselves, the earth and the social field.

Together we want to...

- recognize and discard old patterns,
- clarify our own deeper intentions,
- become quiet and listen within,
- connect with the highest (collective) potential of the future and co-creatively develop something new.

The highest possible future potential of all of us achieves a much greater unfolding when we embark on this journey together, experiencing resonance and encouragement, and opening and holding spaces where everyone is allowed to be who they are and where we empower each other to grow.
